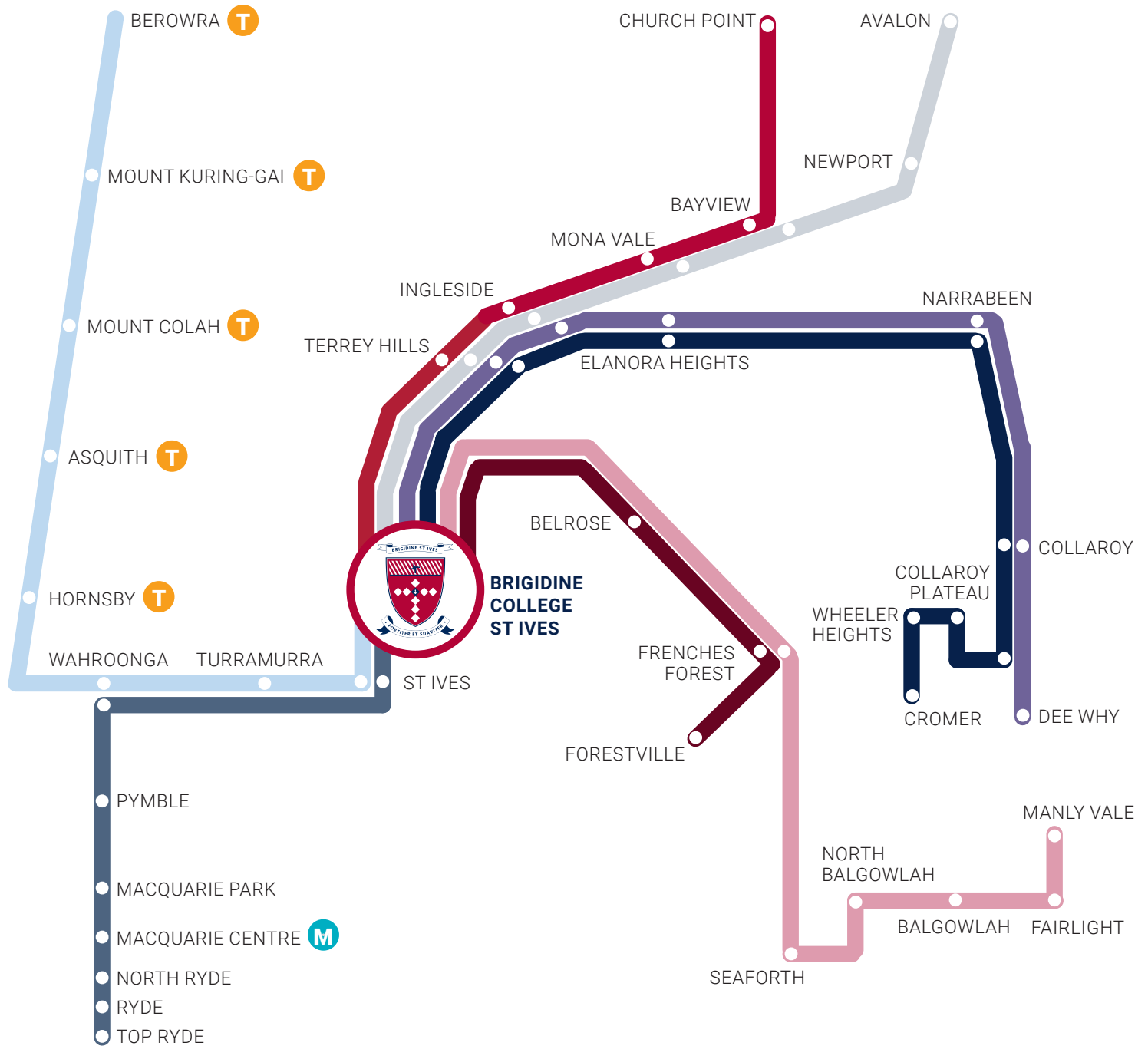
To use the Private Bus Service, please click on the **Register Now** button above.

Brigidine Bus Code of Conduct

All Brigidine students have a right to travel safely. It is each student's responsibility to behave in a manner that ensures the safety and comfort of passengers and drivers at all times on the College's Private Bus services. Traveling on these buses is a privilege and not a right and all students are expected to comply with all School Policies, guidelines and requirements whilst a passenger on this service.

Students using our bus service will use their school issued student ID card as a bus pass. Where able, students will be expected to use their student ID card to tap on/off the service when boarding/alighting. Where a student does not have their student ID card, they are to wait at the end of the line, then manually 'tap on' using the system provided at the front of the bus.

Students accessing the College Private Bus services for travel are expected to verify their understanding and agreement of travel requirements by acknowledging they have read and accept this **Bus Code of Conduct**.

Respect for Peers

Students are expected to:

- Show respect to all students travelling on the bus
- Use a standard conversational tone when speaking on the bus; profanities or offensive language are prohibited.
- Ensure that all digital media i.e. games/music are at an appropriate age rating. Students should not share games or content with younger students.
- Ensure all devices are to be operated with headphones attached so as not to interfere with or distract other passengers or the driver.
- Place bags and other belongings on the floor of the selected seat or in the overhead storage area if available. Do not store bags or personal items on seats that could otherwise be made available.

Personal Safety

To ensure safety all students are required to:

- Wait calmly, quietly and in an orderly manner, away from the road at all times whilst waiting for the bus.
- Remain seated with a seat belt on at all times on the bus.
- Wait until the bus has stopped prior to removing the seat belt.
- Follow the driver's instructions at all times.
- Remain clear of the bus after disembarking to ensure it can safely resume its journey.

Respect for the Bus

Students are required to show care and respect for the bus/driver by:

- Utilising the tap on/tap off where available. Failure to produce an ID card on the afternoon bus run may result in the student being denied access to boarding the bus.
- Showing student ID card to the driver when requested.
- Not distracting the bus driver from driving the bus.
- Keeping all body parts inside the bus at all times; under no circumstances are body parts to protrude from the bus.
- Ensuring objects are not thrown within, or out of the bus.
- Refraining from eating and drinking on the bus. Drinking water is acceptable.
- Abstaining from smoking or vaping on the bus; this is strictly prohibited.
- Respecting the bus and its equipment at all times during travel.
- Disembarking from the bus in an orderly manner
- Student registration for the Annual Bus Pass is required to travel on the Private Bus Service.
Casual/ad hoc rides are not permitted and will incur a \$100 administration fee for each journey.

Consequences

If a student who travels on a College Private Bus services fails to meet the expectations outlined the following consequences will apply:

- An official written warning from the College
- Detention
- A period of time suspended from using the bus service.
- Bus pass revoked. A refund of monies paid will not be issued.

Annual Agreement

All parents and guardians requesting to register their daughter/s on the College Private Bus service must read and understand the expectations within this Code of Conduct. It is essential that parents and guardians also ensure their daughter/s are aware of the Code of Conduct and what their responsibilities and expectations are as bus travellers. During the booking process, parents and guardians will be asked to acknowledge their agreement of the Code of Conduct on behalf of themselves and their daughter/s before registration is accepted. This acknowledgement is required annually.
